

SCHOOL CROSSING PATROL

Traffic and road safety at schools is a matter for everyone in the community. Children are at risk in road environments around schools because they are smaller and less visible to drivers. Their behavior can be less predictable than adults and they may have errors of judgement when dealing with traffic. In particular, younger children do not have well developed peripheral vision. Their cognitive and perceptual abilities combined with their active behavior may put them in higher risk situations in a road environment, particularly at busy times when traffic volumes are high.

The Al Muntazir Primary Schools have undertaken significant steps to ensure increased safety and security of all our children. Introduction of road signs, zebra crossings as well as road bumps have been added around the schools to protect students. Special Road Crossing patrol guards with relevant road signs are fulfilling duties of assisting the young ones to cross roads safely early mornings as well as home time.

The Admin Teams, school staff and support staff are always on the grounds to lead by example engaging in safe crossing habits. An exit pathway has been laid out to allow the students, parents and guardians to leave the building safely. Practical roadside training in pedestrian skills for young children is continuous.
