Science at primary school should nurture this curiosity and allow them to ask questions and develop the skills they need to answer those questions

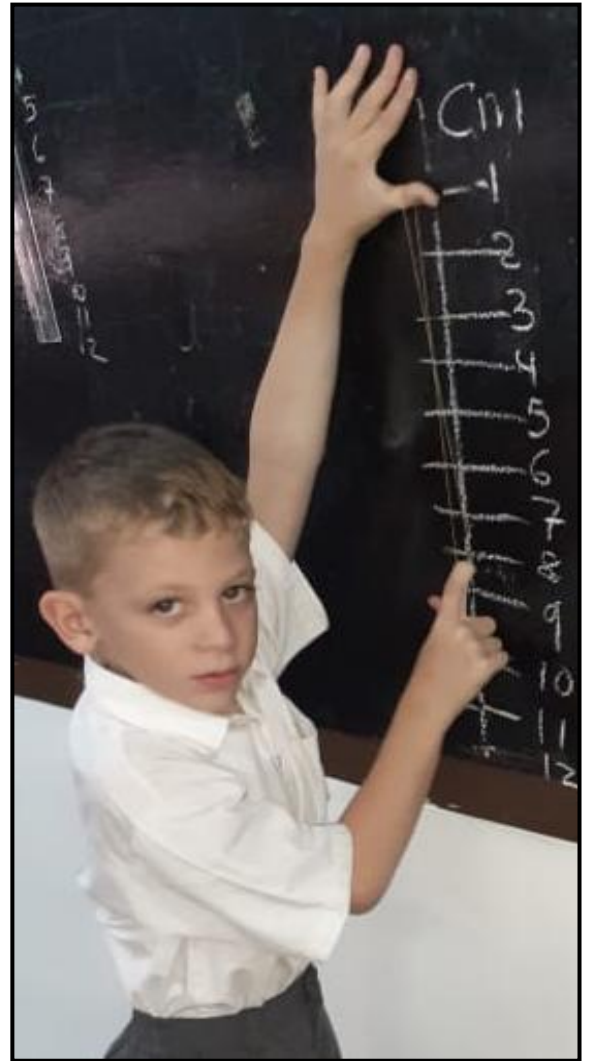
